Don't Get Married Until . . . You Are Willing To Be A Woman! — Week 3

1 Timothy 6:11 says, “But you, man of God, flee from all this, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness.” We all have ideas of what a real woman should be. Some of those ideas are based on what culture tells us, not what God tells us. This week we focus on the characteristics of a woman a godly man should pursue.

- How were you challenged by the message on Sunday?
- What are some false ideas about womanhood we get from culture?
- What does it mean to be a godly woman? What are some signs that would seem to indicate that a woman is godly?
- What does it say to you that Eve’s first relationship was with God, not Adam? Why do many ladies look for a man more than they seek God?
- What is the difference between “godly” and “perfect”? Why is it important for men and women to understand the difference?
- Why do some ladies feel pressure to compromise just to be a relationship?

Single ladies: will you be faithful to God and not compromise what is right in His sight just to have a boyfriend?

Ladies in a dating relationship: Is this the kind of love God meant when He created Adam and Eve, the kind between two people that truly reflects His love for us (the 1 Corinthians 13 kind), or are you settling for less than God’s “immeasurably more than anything you can ask or imagine”?

Married Ladies: Read I Corinthians 13:4-8a and put your name wherever you see the word “love”. This is God’s standard of love! Will you love him...really love him?

Men: a woman’s price is far above rubies. They are valuable. Are you treating the women in your life as precious or are you taking them for granted?
