

for further study:

This week the focus of our service was how Jesus saved people one life at a time. Read the following passages of Scripture, take some personal time to reflect and then use the questions provided to assist you with further reflection.

John 4:1-42

- Did the woman seek Jesus...or did Jesus actually seek the woman? (Who began the conversation?)
- Did the woman recognize who Jesus was at first? (Verse 13)
- Did He ever stop pursuing her?
- Did the fact that He changed her life have an impact on others? (Verse 39)

John 5:1-15 – Read verse 5. Is it EVER too late for Jesus to change someone's life? Is there anyone you have given up on?

John 9:1-41

- Does Jesus always do things in a neat, clean and organized way that everyone will consider to be acceptable? (Verse 6-7)
- Do some people often have a hard time with the way that Jesus chooses to move and change people? (Verse 13-22)
- Can you claim that verse 25 is true for you personally?

John 11:1-44

- Does Jesus always move as soon as we ask Him to? (Verses 1-6)
- Does Jesus ever ask us to do things that do not make sense in order that other people may be reached? (Verses 38-39)
- Is anything really impossible for Jesus—seriously? (Verses 43-44...also see Luke 1:37)

Jesus STILL changes lives. Whose life are you begging Him to change? Are you willing to listen to His voice and then do what He says in order that the change you desire may come about? More on that next week!
