No Perfect People Allowed — Week 1 — Come & See

One of the most powerful phrases in all of scripture is “come and see”. Jesus invites all of us, no matter how broken and imperfect, to come and experience wholeness and fullness in a relationship with the Creator of the universe. As we grow in our faith we get the opportunity and privilege to invite others to “come and see.”

- How did you hear about NewSpring for the first time? What drew you to NewSpring? What has kept you coming back?
- What similarities can you see between Jesus’ strategy for reaching people during His ministry and NewSpring’s strategy for reaching people?
- Read John 1:35-46. Why is the invitation to “Come and See” so powerful? Does an invitation to church count as evangelism?
- John 4:29-30 says, “Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Christ?’ They came out of the town and made their way toward him.” Why did the woman’s invitation have such immediate results? How can we make our personal evangelism opportunities more effective?

As you are sharing your story with family, friends and co-workers, are you putting the cookies on the bottom shelf? Many of us feel that we have to understand everything about the Bible or we make things complicated when really all we need to say is, “come and see.” Who are you compelling to come into a relationship with Jesus? Matthew 18:20 says “For where two or three come together in my name, there I am with them.” Can we as a group come together to pray for the person that you are inviting?
