## The Gospel — Week 1 — Highway to Hell

The good news is that Jesus Christ, the Son of God, was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, died a cruel death to pay for our sins, and rose from the dead to prove his power of sin, hell and the grave. Believing and receiving the good news of Jesus Christ means an abundant life now and an eternity spent in heaven. The consequences of not accepting the finished work of Jesus is an eternity spent separated from Jesus in hell. There are no other options.

- Matthew 7:13-14 says, “Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life and only a few find it.”
- Why do you think Jesus describes belief in this way?
- Why is it socially acceptable to believe anything as long as you don’t bring Jesus into it?
- Is truth exclusive? Where is truth found? (John 17:17)
- What is unique about Jesus? (Is. 7:14, John 1:14, Hebrews 4:14-16, Luke 24:6)
- Acts 4:12 says, “Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.” Where else do people look for salvation?
- It’s been said that if Jesus taught like most pastors today he would have never been crucified. Why does truth offend?
- Why do so many people not believe in hell?

John 14:6 says, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.” Have you accepted that truth? What have you done about it?
