Matthew 16:13-19 says, “When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, “Who do people say the Son of Man is?” They replied, “Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets.” “But what about you?” he asked. “Who do you say I am?” Simon Peter answered, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.”

In this passage we see Jesus asking his disciples a question we will all must answer. Any answer other than Peter’s is wrong.

What does the world say about Jesus? What would you say to someone who says that Jesus was just a great teacher or moral figure?

How can our lives show what we believe about Jesus?

Whose life are you begging God to change in 2010?

What commitment do you need to make to Jesus in 2010?
